Feeders





 Prepare a bird feeder.

 Put some unsalted peanuts, wild bird seed, crumbled or grated cheese, raisins and other dried fruit.







 Remember that each bird has a different taste associated with food. For example, smaller birds swallow all seeds. Not all seeds are suitable for all birds. Tits, for example, like bacon fat, which you can hang on a string. Remember that it cannot be salted.

## Remember





- To put some food for the pigeons in the parks; you can scatter some grains, corn or even crumbs of bread.
- To give the birds plenty of water to drink and to bathe in.
- To change the water and clean the bowl.
- To remove old food and clean the bird table.
- To feed the birds during the whole winter.
